



African Parks Network Restocking Program

Majete Game Reserve

August 2010



In August 2010, the Conservation Solutions team will be capturing and translocating 600 plains game from Liwonde and Lengwe National Parks, to Majete Game Reserve in Southern Malawi.

Using our specialised capture and transport equipment, sable, waterbuck and impala will be selected and herded into a funnel boma. Conservation Solutions uses the services of Mr. Barney O'Hara who operates a Hughes 500 MB helicopter during capture operations. The antelope will then be transported by road to Majete Game Reserve where they will be released.

A number of elephants, which were previously translocated to Majete Game Reserve by Conservation Solutions' team members in 2006 had radio collars fitted for monitoring. These collars need to be replaced every 3 years. Conservation Solutions will be fitting new collars to these elephants during operations in Majete in August this year.

African Parks Network is conducting a guest program during the capture period, which offers guests an exciting opportunity to experience wildlife capture first hand. Participating guests will be housed in the luxurious Mvuu Lodge, Liwonde National Park and Thawale Tented Camp, Majete Game Reserve over 6 days.
