# African Wildlife Capture Participation Program



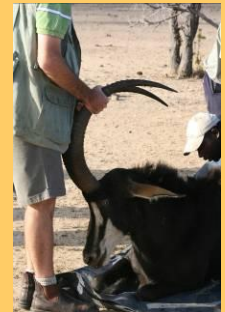
## ELANDSBERG WILDLIFE RESERVE, LIMPOPO, SOUTH AFRICA

Conservation Solutions is offering a unique opportunity to learn the skills for chemical immobilization of African mammals and the techniques used in mass capture of antelope and buffalo species. Rhino and elephant darting may be included during this participation program. A three week program will be presented at **Elandsberg Wildlife Reserve** and the neighboring conservancies. The program will include the following:



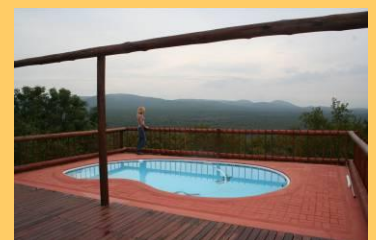
### Week 1 and 2:

- Identifying mammals, birds and trees
- Field tracking skills and identifying spoor
- Introduction to Chemical Immobilization
- Dangerous drugs and safety precautions
- Safe dart gun handling and practical darting
- Helicopter safety procedures
- Mass capture techniques
- Constructing of capture bomas



### Week 3:

- Mass capture participation
- Participation in darting sable, eland, kudu, buffalo, possibly elephant and rhino
- Antelope Pregnancy testing, general vaccinating and blood testing.



### Program Accommodation:

- Participants are housed in the luxurious Elandsberg Lodge.
- Costs include 3 meals per day and laundry.
- Three game drives included and a visit to Markakele National Park.
